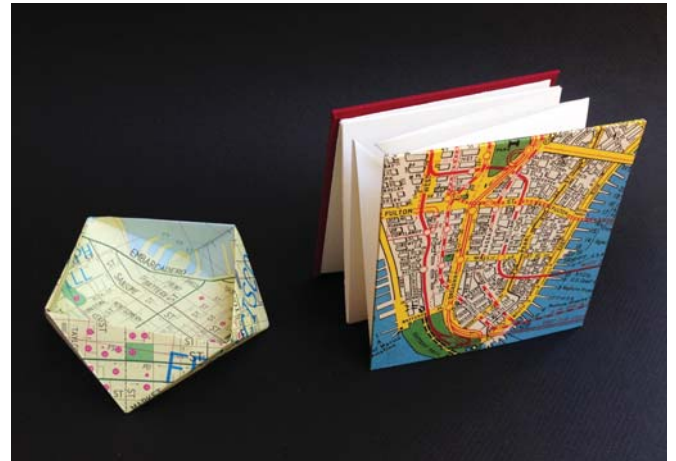


Construct an Album from Hardware Parts
